

# FLYING A DRONE?

The popularity of small unmanned aircraft, sometimes called UAVs or drones, is growing and owners are now being advised to pay more attention to safety issues.

People flying these unmanned aircraft should understand that they are subject to aviation rules, and should not treat the devices as harmless gadgets or toys.

You **MUST** keep the unmanned aircraft within your sight at all times.



You are **LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE** for the safe conduct of each flight.



If you intend to use an unmanned aircraft for commercial use, you must get 'Permission' from the Director of Civil Aviation prior to activity.



You **MUST NOT** fly your unmanned aircraft within 50m of a person, vehicle or building that is not under your control.  
**STAY WELL CLEAR OF AIRPORTS.**
