AIR NAVIGATION (OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 2013

DIRECTION

Pursuant to a designation by His Excellency the Governor and in accordance with Article 68(1) of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013 (AN(OT)O), the Director of Civil Aviation issues the following **DIRECTION** which shall have effect from 30th May 2017 until such time as it is varied, suspended or revoked.

IT IS DIRECTED THAT:

- a) Small unmanned aircraft must not be flown at any height directly over a minefield where a person is working
- b) Small unmanned aircraft must not be flown within 500m horizontally of a minefield where a person is working

TAKE NOTE

It is a criminal offence to contravene terms of this Direction.

Information

Small Unmanned aircraft are also commonly referred to as drones, quadcopters, small unmanned surveillance aircraft and unmanned aerial vehicles, etc.

A person who needs to fly a SUA contrary to this Direction must obtain written permission from the person who has charge of mine clearance operations and must operate in accordance with the AN(OT)O.

This Direction is issued, in addition to the existing Regulations that apply to SUA operations (see www.airsafety.aero/sua), and is done so to ensure the safety of persons engaged in the operation of minefield clearance work.
