

## Northbound Flight Checklist (Falkland Islands to England)

<p><b>Red, amber and green list rules for entering England</b>          As from 17 May 2021 the Falkland Islands is on the Green list. <p><b>Before Travel to England from the Falkland Islands:</b></p>	
<p>Complete the UK Passenger Locator Form prior to northbound travel, 48 hours before you are due to land in England. This is available on the UK Government’s website: <a href="https://www.gov.uk/provide-journey-contact-details-before-travel-uk">https://www.gov.uk/provide-journey-contact-details-before-travel-uk</a></p>	
<p>Before leaving to travel to England, passengers must book and pay for a <u>day-2</u> Covid-19 test only. <p><b>Note:</b> Persons travelling to England from the Falkland Islands are exempt the requirement to take a pre-flight Covid-19 test. <p><b>On arrival in England from the Falkland Islands:</b></p>	
<p>You must take a Covid-19 test on day-2 after you arrive.          You do not need to quarantine unless your day-2 Covid-19 test is positive.  <a href="https://www.gov.uk/guidance/red-amber-and-green-list-rules-for-entering-england">https://www.gov.uk/guidance/red-amber-and-green-list-rules-for-entering-england</a></p>

## Southbound Flight Checklist (England to the Falkland Islands)

<p>Travel to the Falkland Islands is currently restricted due to Covid-19. Visitors who meet the requirements detailed at <a href="https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound">https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound</a> will need to be approved through the CD19 application process before a flight can be booked. Note: CD19 applications are not required from passengers who have Falkland Islands Status, those who have Permanent Residence Permits or those who hold work permits.</p> <p><i>CD19 forms</i>, which are also known as <i>Non-Essential Visitors Application Forms</i> can be found at <a href="https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound">https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound</a></p> <p>Completed forms are to be returned to <a href="mailto:Immigration2@customs.gov.fk">Immigration2@customs.gov.fk</a></p>	
<p>Before taking a southbound flight make sure you have secured accommodation which can be used for 14 days quarantine on your arrival in the Falkland Islands. <p>Before taking a southbound flight make sure you have arranged transportation to your quarantine accommodation – this is either in government-designated transport or in a private vehicle travelling alone or with another person or persons who are also going straight into quarantine. <p>Before you take your southbound flight make sure you complete and return an <i>IDC5 form</i> – this will be sent to you by the flight booking office and can also be found as a downloadable document at <a href="https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound">https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound</a></p>	
<p>All travellers to the Falkland Islands aged two years and over will need to provide proof of a negative PCR test for Covid-19 no more than five days before arrival in Senegal from the UK. Proof of this test is to be presented at Brize Norton at flight check-in. For more information see <i>Southbound FAQs 'What are my options for booking a test?'</i> at <a href="https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound">https://fig.gov.fk/covid-19/travel/southbound</a></p> <p>If there is a delayed flight, passengers should contact <a href="mailto:travel@falklands.gov.fk">travel@falklands.gov.fk</a> for queries relating to tests.</p> <p>Passengers who are unable to afford the Covid-19 PCR test upfront should email <a href="mailto:contactadmin@falklands.gov.fk">contactadmin@falklands.gov.fk</a> in the first instance for a possible temporary loan to cover the test costs. NHS testing centres are <u>NOT</u> to be used for the purpose of travel PCR tests.</p>
