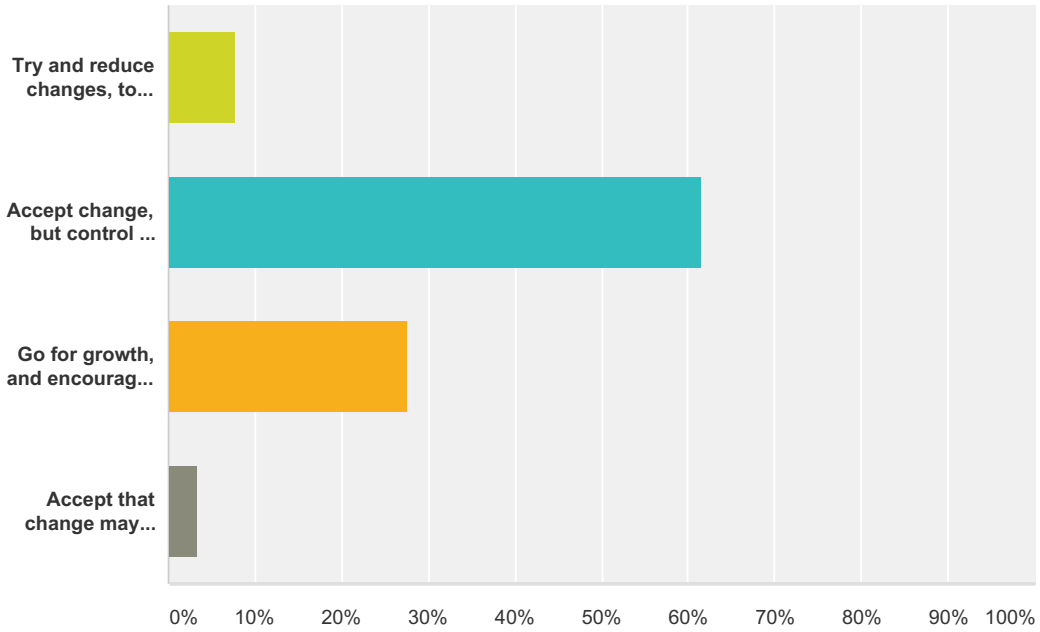


### Q1 How should we respond to change?

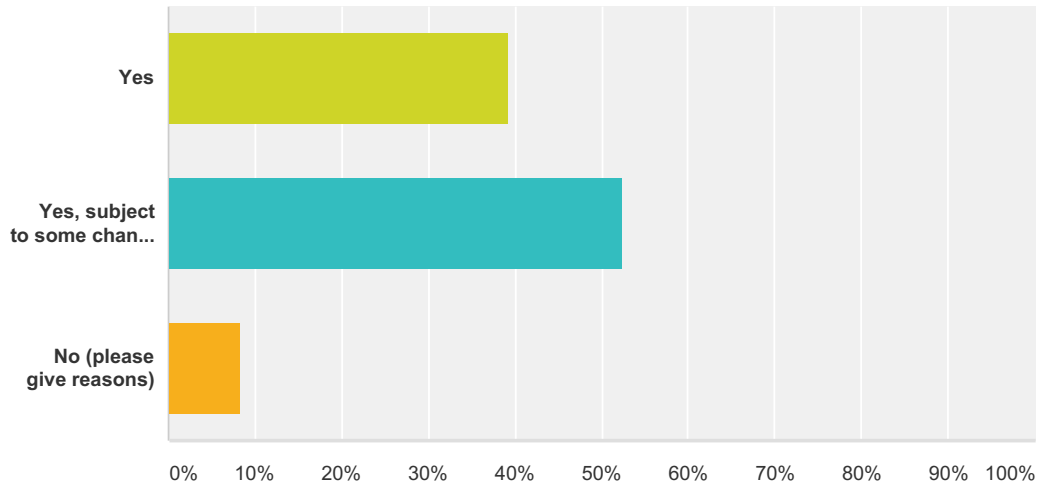

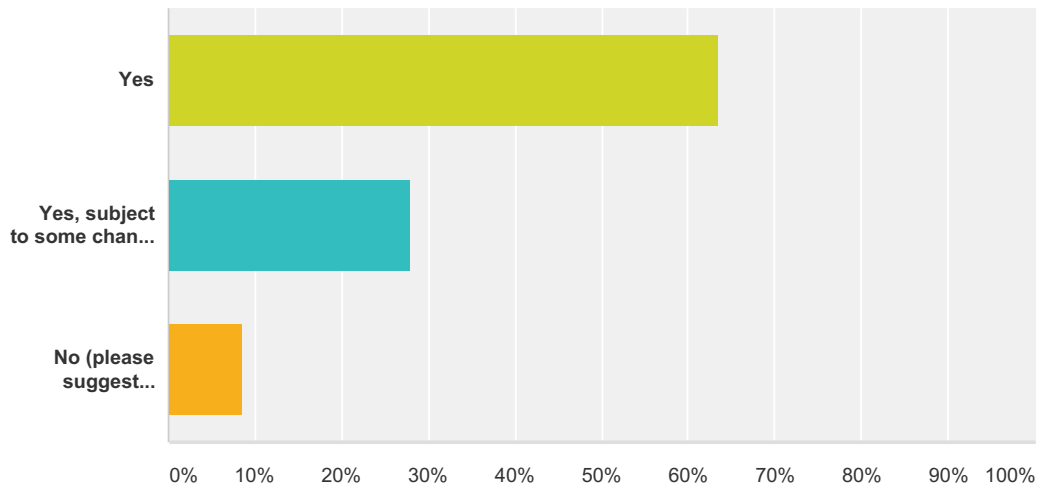

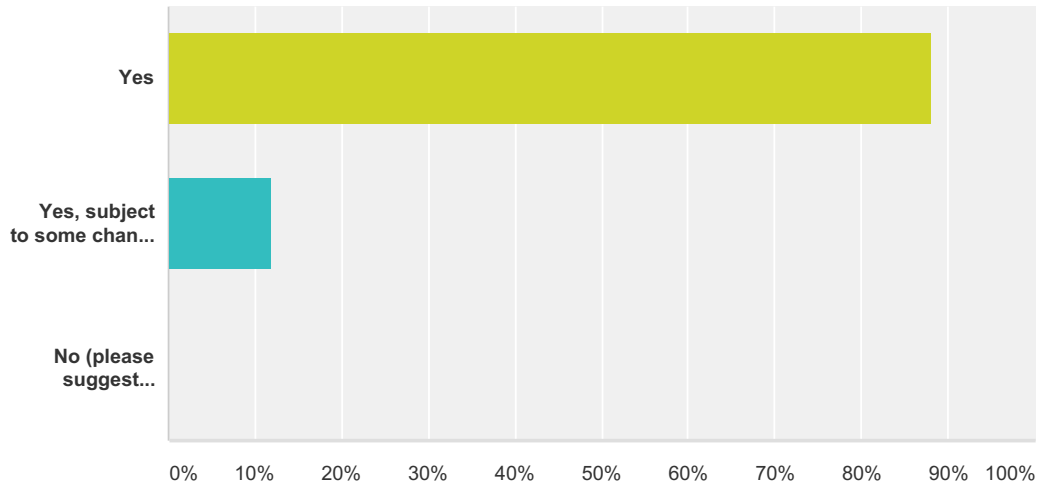

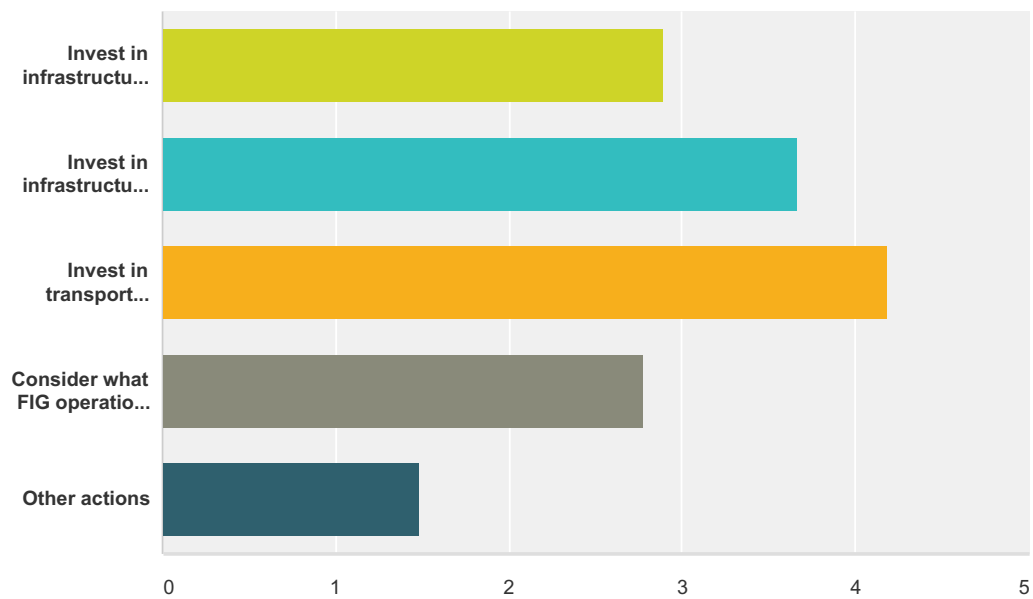

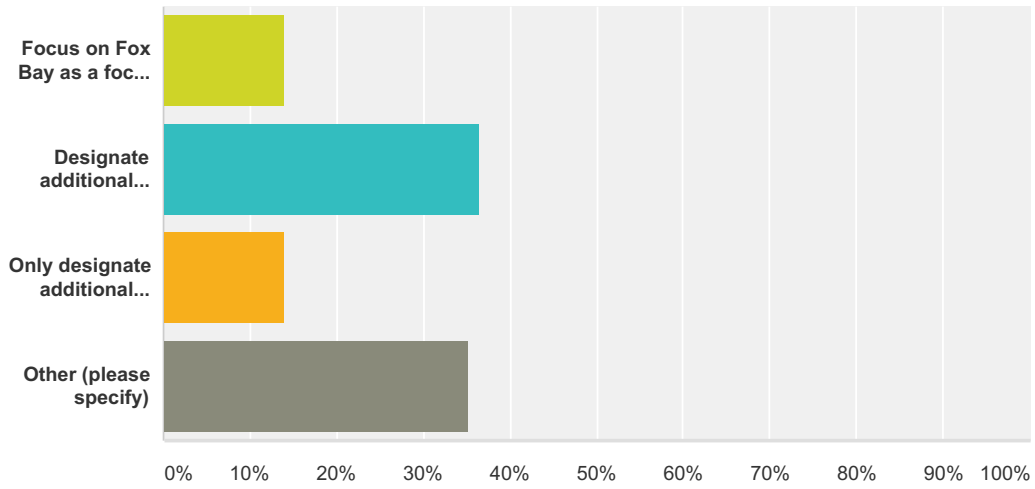

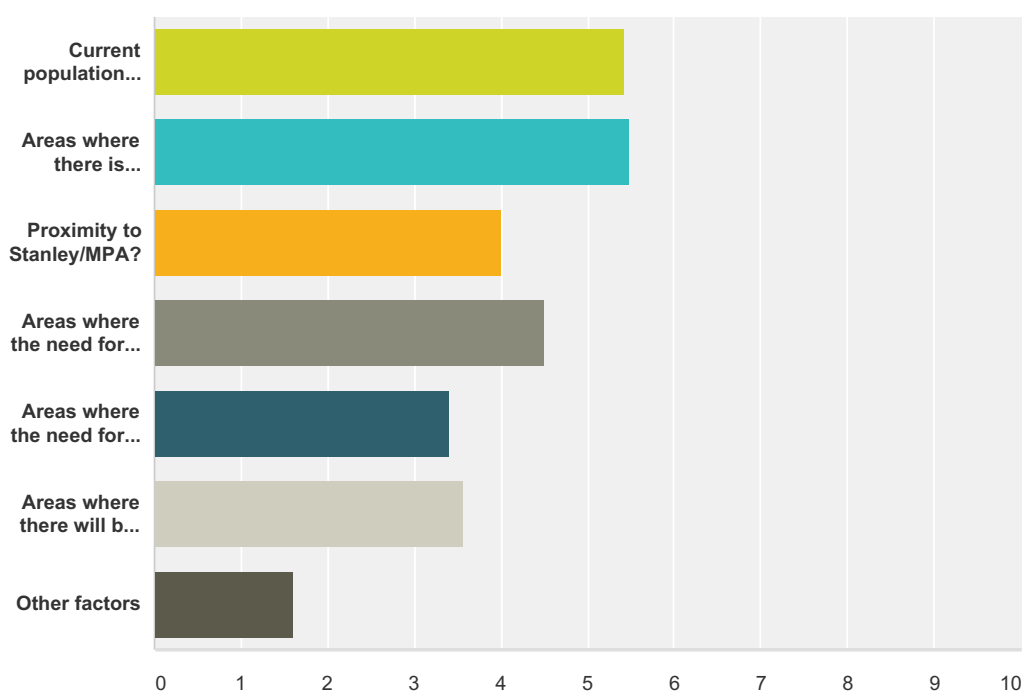

### Q10 If an additional Enterprise Zone were to be established, where would you locate it?

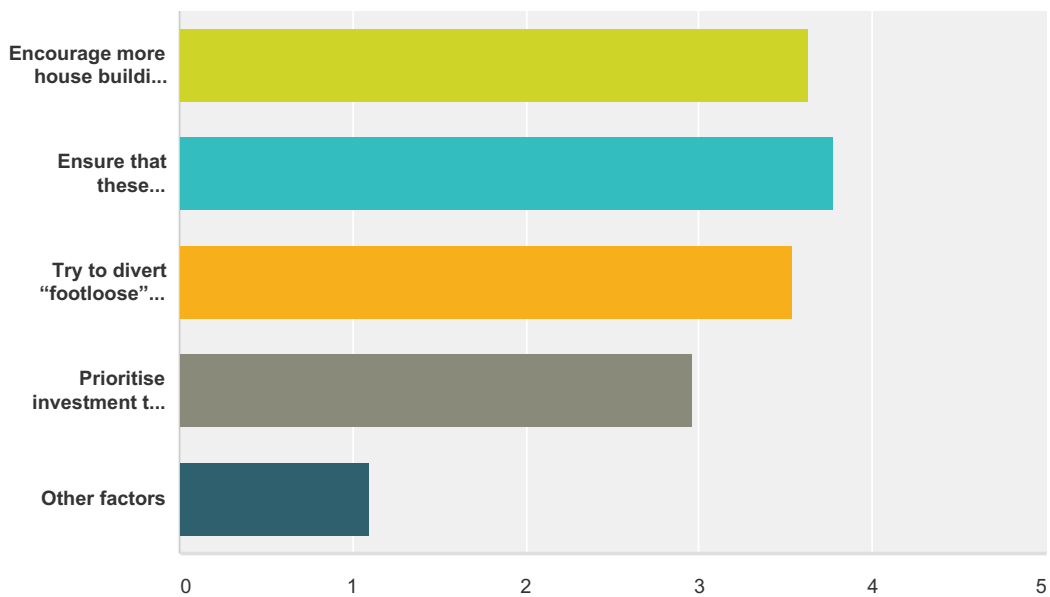

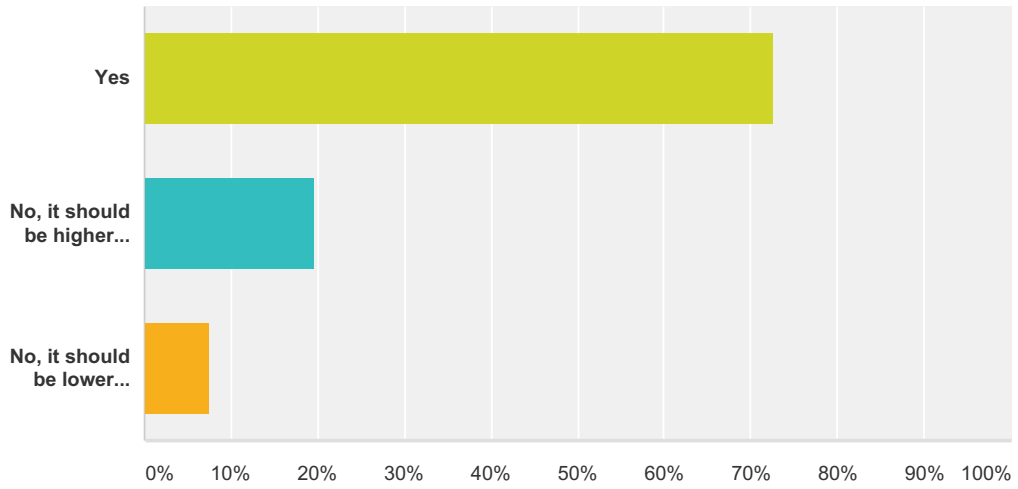

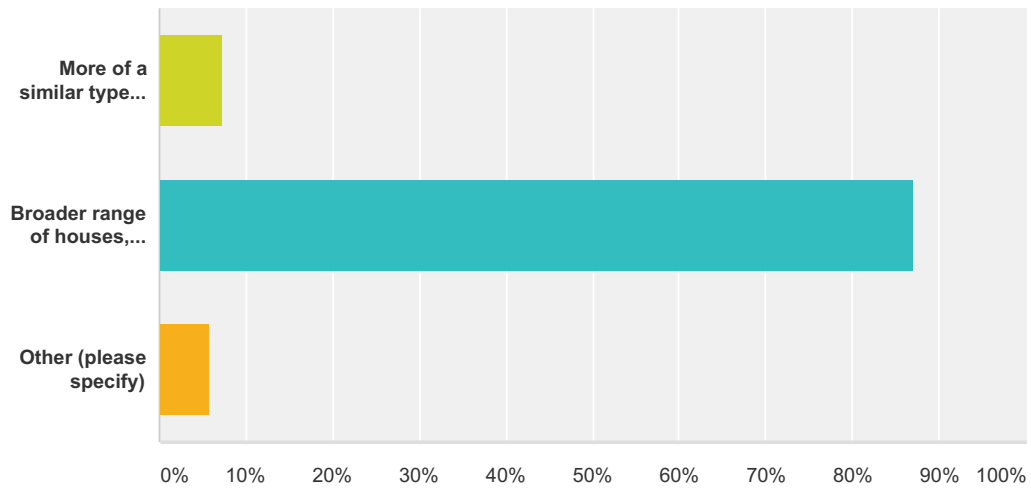

### Q14 What type of houses do we need?

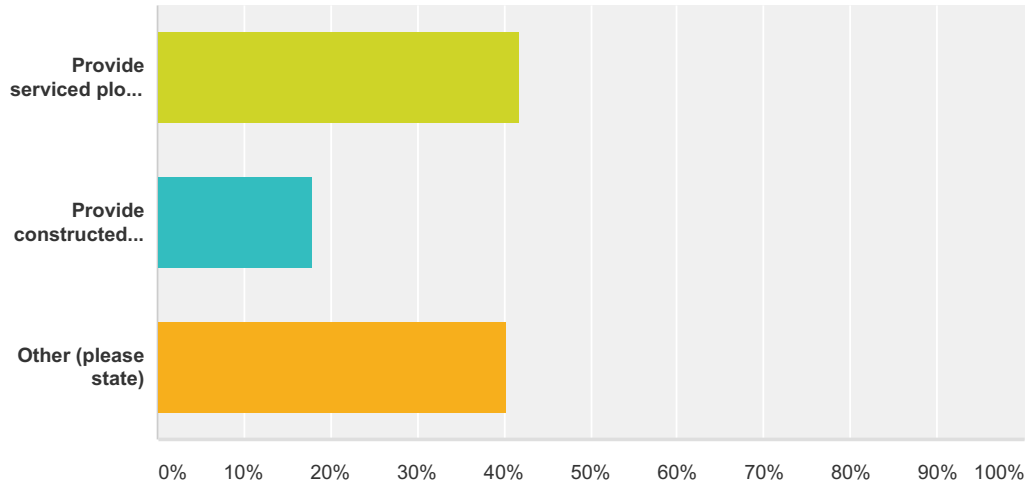

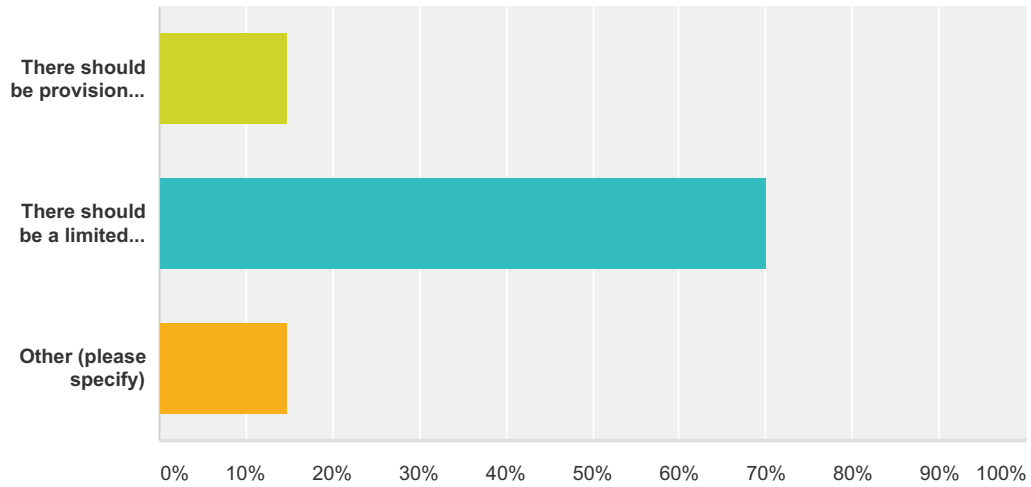

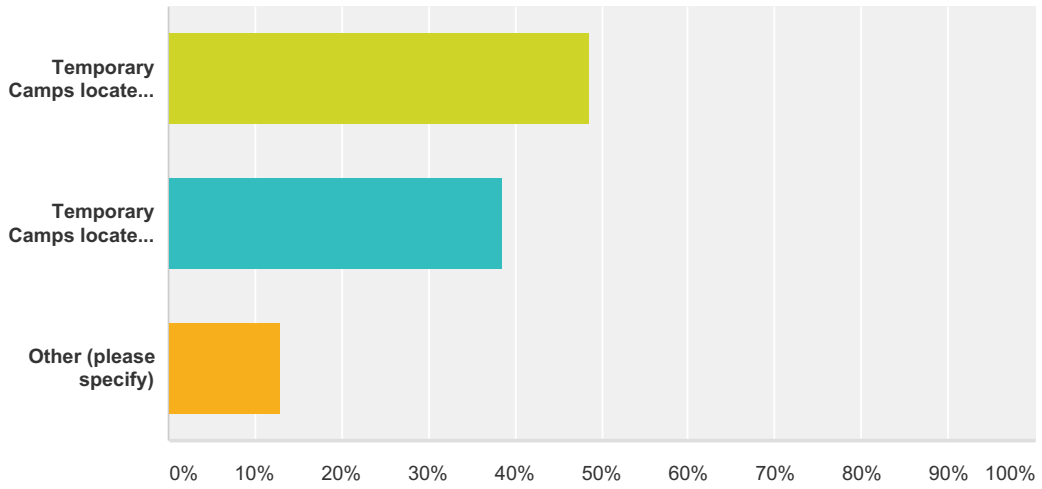

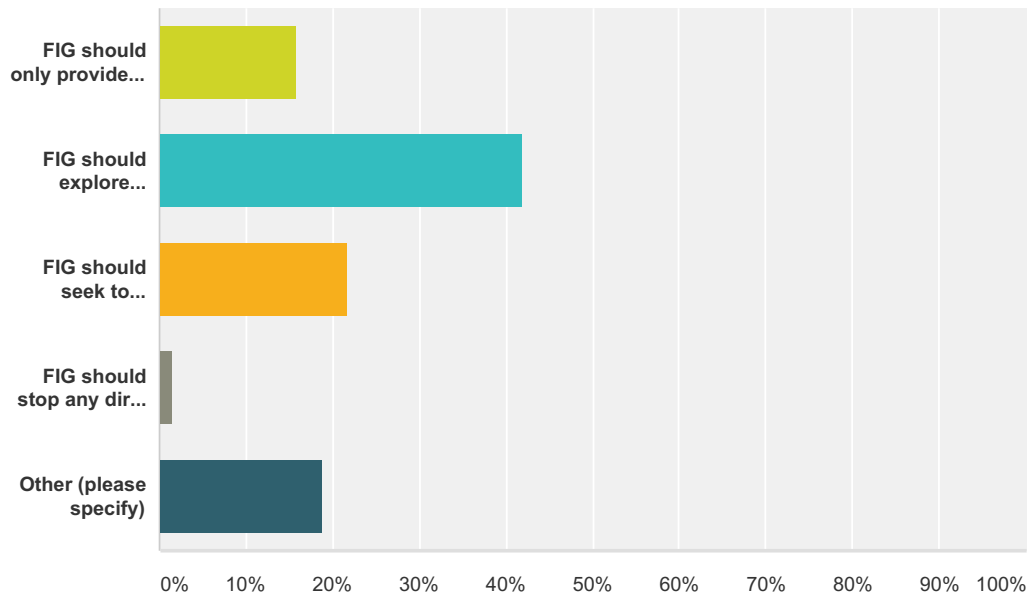

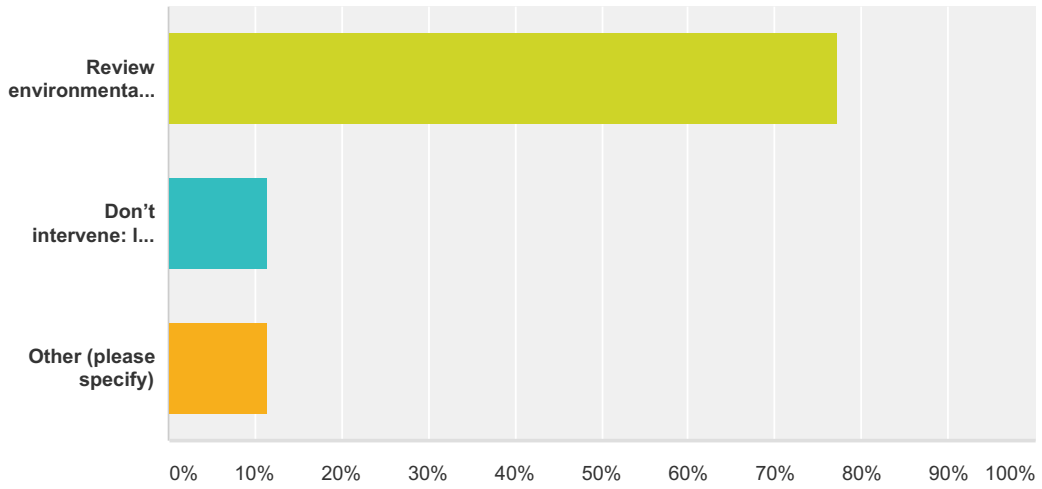

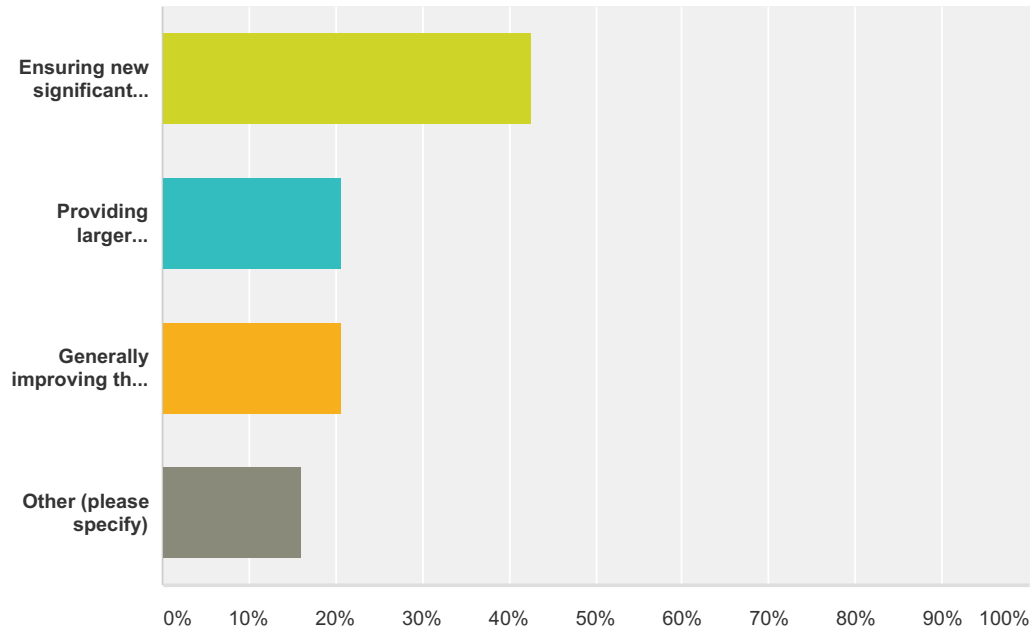

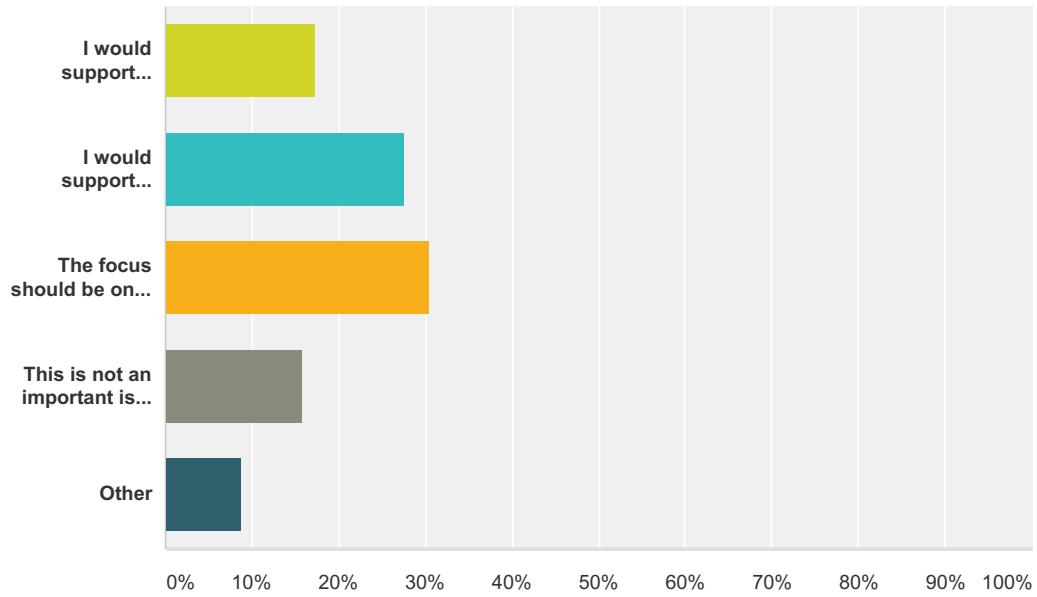

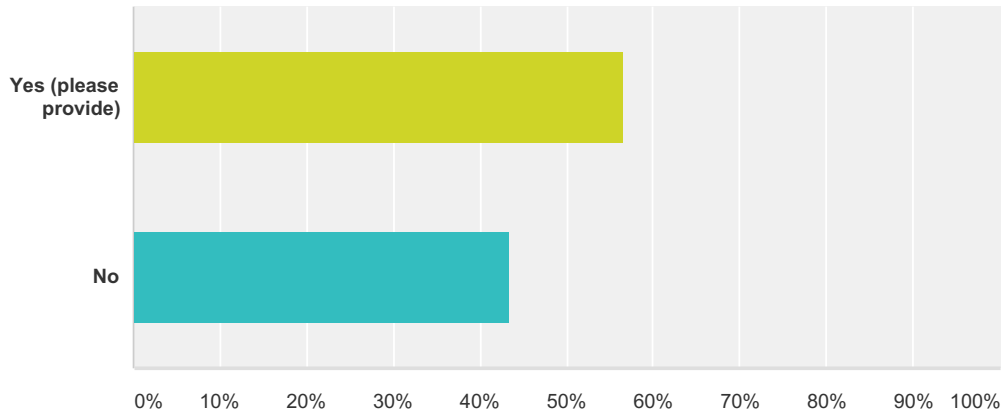

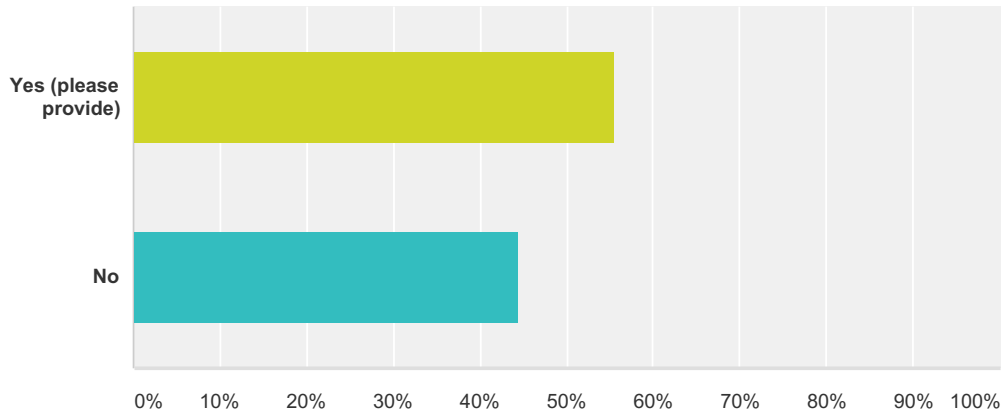
